Documentation or attestation of the management of obstetrical and gynecological problems for at least 100 inpatients or outpatients as the attending physician (or senior resident) during the past two years.

	Privileges to evaluate, diagnose, consult perform history and physical exam, and manage the care of female patients in any condition or stage of pregnancy who present to the outpatient clinic and the Emergency Department.	
	Outpatient Obstetrics (For those with teaching appointments and who do not require in-patient or admitting privileges)	
	Privileges to evaluate, diagnose, consult perform history and physical exam, and manage the care of female patients in any condition or stage of pregnancy who present to the outpatient clinic and the Emergency Department.	
	Gynecology	
	Privileges to admit, evaluate, diagnose, consult, perform history and physical exam, and provide pre-operative, intraoperative, and post-operative care necessary in the outpatient clinic and hospital for management of female patients presenting with illness, injuries, and disorders of the gynecologic or genitourinary system, and nonsurgical treatment of illnesses and injuries of the mammary glands. Cystoscopy, diagnostic and operative hysteroscopy and laparoscopy.	
	Obstetrics	

	Admit, treat, perform history and physical exam, or provide follow-up care to female patients presenting in any condition or stage of pregnancy, including injuries and disorders of the reproductive system.	
	Pediatric/Adolescent Obstetrics and Gynecology	
	Privileges to admit, treat, perform history and physical exam, and provide medical and surgical care of pubertal/menarchal girls >14 yo with routine gynecologic illnesses, injuries, and disorders of the gynecologic or genitourinary system. Routine surgical care would include surgical management of ovarian cysts, adnexal torsion, ectopic pregnancy, vulvar lacerations, common abnormalities of the hymen (such as imperforate hymen). This does not include labiaplasty procedures.	
	Privileges to provide basic surgical care of prepubertal girls <=14 yo limited to repair of vulvar lacerations.	
	Gynecologic Oncology (CRITERIA - Initial - Subspecialty board certification or active candidacy with full subspecialty certification required within five (5) years of completion of fellowship, and ongoing recertification or foreign equivalent training/board. Renewal appointments may be documented by board certification or documentation of clinical experience .)	
	Privileges to admit, evaluate, diagnose, consult, perform history and physical exam, and perform history and physical exam provide surgical care, and medically manage the care of women with malignant diseases of the reproductive tract and peritoneum, including the ovaries, fallopian tubes, uterus, uterine cervix, vulva and vagina; and trophoblastic diseases. Cystoscopy and biopsy, intraperitoneal catheter placement, chest tube placement, laparoscopic lymphadenectomy and cancer staging operations, including pelvic, para-aortic and scalene lymphadenectomy. Use of lasers. Radical and microsurgical operations in the abdomen and pelvis required to treat these conditions, including radical debulking operations, radical hysterectomy, vulvectomy, splenectomy, pelvic exenteration, including construction of a neovagina, harvesting of skin and myocutaneous grafts, and performance of procedures on the bowel and urinary tract as indicated, including ureters, bladder, urethra, e.g., urinary diversion, neocystostomy, intestinal resection and reanastomosis.	
	Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility (CRITERIA - Initial - Subspecialty board certification or active candidacy with full subspecialty certification required within five (5) years of completion of fellowship, and ongoing recertification or foreign equivalent training/board. Renewal appointments may be documented by board certification or documentation of clinical experience.)	
	Special procedures required for in vitro fertilization, and microsurgery related to infertility.	
	Urogynecology and Pelvic Reconstructive Surgery (CRITERIA - Subspecialty board certification or active candidacy with full subspecialty certification required within five (5) years of completion of fellowship, and ongoing recertification or foreign equivalent training/board. New subspecialty, for those who have been practicing urogynecology prior to the establishment of subspecialty fellowship training programs, privileges may be granted by documentation of clinical experience))	
	Privileges to admit, evaluate, diagnose, consult, perform history and physical exam and provide surgical and medical management for the care of women with pelvic floor disorders. Specialized procedures and reconstructive operations of the female pelvis for the treatment of urinary or fecal dysfunction. Diagnostic and treatment modalities include multi-channel urodynamic testing, endoanal ultrasound, bladder instillation therapies, diagnostic and operative cystoscopy, ureteral stent placement, transurethral injection of bulk-enhancing agents, use of grafts for reconstructive procedures, endoscopic operations for treatment of urinary problems and pelvic floor defects, placement of sacral neuromodulators under fluoroscopic guidance, neovaginal reconstruction.

[CRITERIA - Initial - Documentation of training and competency during residency or specialized post-residency training in 2nd trimester abortion techniques with documentation of a minimum 5 cases required during the past 2 years. For those applicants >2 years out of residency; A statement of training in 2nd trimester abortion techniques from residency program director, plus documentation of 5 cases in last 2 years. Renewal - Minimum 5 cases required during the past 2 years]	
	Advanced Family Planning: Dilation and evacuation of the pregnant uterus beyond 19 weeks gestation. [CRITERIA - Initial - Documentation of training and competency during residency or specialized post-residency training in 2nd trimester abortion techniques with documentation of a minimum 5 cases required during the past 2 years. For those applicants >2 years out of residency; A statement of training in 2nd trimester abortion techniques from residency program director, plus documentation of 5 cases in last 2 years. Renewal - Minimum 5 cases required during the past 2 years]	
	Central Venous Catheter Insertion [CRITERIA - Complete "Getting to Zero" educational module. Minimum 10 cases done in the past two years. Case log required - Initial only]	
	Emergency privileges—in the absence of availability of Pediatric and Adolescent gynecologists, to provide services in children >=14 yo similar to procedures in adults (eg vaginoscopy, D&C, adnexal torsion, surgical management of ovarian cysts)	
	Privileges to admit, treat, perform history and physical exam, and provide medical and surgical gynecologic care of prepubertal girls < 14 yo (CRITERIA - Initial - Completion of Pediatric and Adolescent Gynecology fellowship or by documentation of clinical experience)
